Colorado Revised Statutes – 22-1-125. Automated external defibrillators in public schools.

• Encourages school districts to acquire and maintain AEDs on public school grounds. Also outlines appropriate funding and FDA standards and limits use to school property and school events.

Colorado Revised Statutes – 22-1-125.5. Requirement for certification of public school athletic coaches in cardiopulmonary resuscitation – use of AED – definitions.

• Coaches of athletic programs employed by local education providers must be currently certified in CPR and AED use

Good Samaritan Laws

Colorado Revised Statutes – 13-21-108.1. Persons rendering emergency assistance through the use of AEDs – limited immunity

- The general assembly encourages the use of AEDs for the purpose of saving the lives of people in cardiac arrest by requiring a person or entity who acquires an AED to ensure that:
 - o Expected users receive training in CPR and AED use
 - o The AED is maintained and tested according to the manufacturer's guidelines
 - o Written records maintained of AED maintenance and testing
 - o Written plans are in place
- Uses key verbiage to describe who shall not be liable for civil damages when rendering emergency care or treatment by the use of an AED
