#### **AED Placement in Schools**

**South Carolina Code**, § **59-17-155**. Automated external defibrillator program; immunity from civil liability; state contract for purchase of defibrillators.

- Mandates each school district develop and implement an automated external defibrillator (AED) program that includes provisions for an operational AED on the grounds of the high school
- Also outlines the requirements for training of expected users, inspections and maintenance and the manner of program operation.

# **School Staff CPR/AED Training**

**South Carolina Code**, § **59-17-155**. Automated external defibrillator program; immunity from civil liability; state contract for purchase of defibrillators.

• Mandates that all persons reasonably expected (as determined by the school district superintendent or designed) to use the AED obtain appropriate training, including completion of a course in CPR and demonstrated proficiency in the use of an AED

#### **Good Samaritan Laws**

**South Carolina Code**, § **59-17-155**. Automated external defibrillator program; immunity from civil liability; state contract for purchase of defibrillators.

- Uses key verbiage to describe immunity from civil liability for the use of an AED (unless gross negligence is present during application) for the following:
  - o Persons or entities acting in good faith
  - o Prescribing physicians when authorizing the purchase of an AED
  - o Persons who teach or provide training

**South Carolina Code**, § **44-76-40**. Immunity from civil liability for use of automated external defibrillator.
