

# ALABAMA

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## **SCHOOLS:**

### **AED Placement**

#### **Alabama Code-- § 16-1-45. Automated external defibrillator requirements.**

- *An automated external defibrillator shall be in each K-12 public school. At least one employee shall be trained to use the AED as designated by superintendent.*

#### **Alabama Code -- § 16-30D-21 - Cardiac Emergency Response Plan Required**

- *Starting 2025-2026 school year, AEDs placement on school property in accordance with the AHA and evidence-based guidelines. Details related to locations and signage is included.*

### **CPR/AED Training for staff and/or Cardiac Emergency Response Plans (CERP) and/or Emergency Action Plans (EAP)**

#### **Alabama Code -- § 6-5-332.3 - Use of Automated External Defibrillator**

- *Description of AED including responsibilities for the person or entity that acquires an AED including education and maintenance.*

#### **Alabama Code-- § 16-1-45. Automated external defibrillator requirements.**

- *An automated external defibrillator shall be in each K-12 public school. At least one employee shall be trained to use the AED as designated by superintendent.*

#### **Alabama Code -- § 16-30D-21 - Cardiac Emergency Response Plan Required**

- *Starting 2025-2026 school year, schools should develop and implement cardiac emergency response plans, cardiac emergency response team, in line with evidence-based guidelines which includes response to athletics on school property. Plan to be disseminated*



## **YOUTH SPORTS GROUPS:**

### **AED Placement**

#### **Alabama Code -- § 16-30D-21 - Cardiac Emergency Response Plan Required**

- *Starting 2025-2026 school year, AEDs placement on school property including athletic event spaces in accordance with the AHA and evidence-based guidelines. Details related to locations and signage are included.*

### **CPR/AED Training for coaches and/or Cardiac Emergency Response Plans (CERP) and/or Emergency Action Plans (EAP)**

#### **Alabama Code -- § 16-30-D - Sudden cardiac arrest education in schools (Tyrell Spencer Act)**

- *Beginning the 2024-2025 school year, all student athletes and his/her/their parent/guardian shall receive and acknowledge information sheet on cardiac arrest signs and symptoms as developed by the State Board of Education as an eligibility requirement.*
- *Further language pertaining to material development, education, and tracking the required education for student athletes, parents, and coaches.*

## **GOOD SAMARITAN LAWS:**

#### **Alabama Code-- § 6-5-332. Persons rendering emergency care, etc., at scene of accident, etc.**

- *Uses key verbiage to describe immunity from civil liability while rendering emergency care or treatment to a person suffering or appearing to suffer from cardiac arrest.*

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
