Colorado Revised Statutes –§ 22-1-129.7. Placement and maintenance of automated external defibrillator- definition

- *By January 1st, 2026, public and nonpublic schools that have an AED are required to place and maintain AED according to nationally recognized standards.*

Colorado Revised Statutes -- § 25-53-102 – Placement of automated external defibrillator – donations – acquisitions – limited immunity

- *Mandates public schools to place functional AEDs in quantities to ensure reasonable availability*
- *Describes required actions if a public school accepts a donated AED*

CPR/AED Training for coaches and/or Cardiac Emergency Response Plans (CERP) and/or Emergency Action Plans (EAP)

Colorado Revised Statutes –§ 22-1-125.5 – Requirement for certification of public school athletic coaches in cardiopulmonary resuscitation – use of automated external defibrillators

- *Mandates that coaches of athletic programs employed by local education providers must be currently certified in CPR and must have received instruction in AED use.*

GOOD SAMARITAN LAWS:

Colorado Revised Statutes –§ 13-21-108.1. Persons rendering emergency assistance through the use of AEDs – limited immunity

- *Uses key verbiage to describe who shall not be liable for civil damages when rendering emergency care or treatment by the use of an AED*
