SCHOOLS:

AED Placement

Delaware Code of Regulations – 16 Del. Admin. Code § 4303 Automatic External Defibrillation

- *(5.1) States that any school is eligible to become an Early Defibrillation Service*
- *(6.1) Schools must make application to OEMS (Delaware State Office of Emergency Medical Services) prior to implementation of an early defibrillation program. Further describes responsibilities of the service if implemented.*

CPR/AED Training for staff and/or Cardiac Emergency Response Plans (CERP) and/or Emergency Action Plans (EAP)

YOUTH SPORTS GROUPS:

AED Placement

Delaware Code – 14 Del. C. § 303 – Regulations, Policies, and Procedures

- *Requires that an AED be placed in accordance with nationally recognized guidelines and be clearly marked and easily accessible in an unlocked location at each school athletic venue during a school sponsored event or practice. Must be tested and maintained according to manufacturer's guidelines.*

CPR/AED Training for coaches and/or Cardiac Emergency Response Plans (CERP) and/or Emergency Action Plans (EAP)

Delaware Code – 14 Del. C. § 303 – Regulations, Policies, and Procedures

- *Requires each school with an athletic department or program to develop an athletic EAP*
- *All coaches must obtain and maintain certification in CPR, first aid and use of an AED*



GOOD SAMARITAN LAWS:

Delaware Code of Regulations –16 Del. C. § 3005C. Provision of limited liability protections.

- *Uses key verbiage to describe immunity from civil liability while rendering emergency care or treatment to a person suffering or appearing to suffer from cardiac arrest*
