SCHOOLS:

AED Placement

Illinois Administrative Code -- § 210 ILCS 74/1 – 74/55 - Physical Fitness Facility Medical Emergency Preparedness Act

- *Outlines requirements for a “physical fitness facility” or “facility” that is owned or operated by a public or private elementary or secondary school, college, university, or technical or trade school*

Illinois Compiled Statutes -- § 105 ILCS 5/10-20.87 – Automated External Defibrillator, Attendance Centers and Extracurricular Activities

- *A school district shall require at least one automated external defibrillator to be present during the school day and during school-sponsored extracurricular activities on school grounds*

CPR/AED Training for staff and/or Cardiac Emergency Response Plans (CERP) and/or Emergency Action Plans (EAP)

Illinois Compiled Statutes -- § 105 ILCS 5/22-115 – Emergency procedures and life-saving techniques

- *Mandates that no later than 30 days after first day of each school year, the school shall provide staff with information regarding life-saving techniques including Hands-Only CPR and AED use.*

Illinois Compiled Statutes -- § 105 ILCS 128/60 – Cardiac Emergency Response Plan

- *Mandates that a school district and a private school shall develop a cardiac emergency response plan which includes procedural instructions, a listing of every AED location and information on Hands-only CPR and AED use to teachers, coaches, etc.*

AED Placement

Illinois Compiled Statutes -- § 105 ILCS 5/10-20.87 – Automated External Defibrillator, Attendance Centers and Extracurricular Activities

- *A school district shall require at least one automated external defibrillator to be present during the school day and during school-sponsored extracurricular activities on school grounds*

CPR/AED Training for coaches and/or Cardiac Emergency Response Plans (CERP) and/or Emergency Action Plans (EAP)

Illinois Compiled Statutes -- § 105 ILCS 5/22-115 – Emergency procedures and life-saving techniques

- *States that school boards are urged to encourage their teachers and other school personnel who coach school athletic programs and other extracurricular school activities to maintain skills necessary to properly administer first aid and CPR*

Illinois Compiled Statutes -- § 105 ILCS 128/60 – Cardiac Emergency Response Plan

- *Mandates that a school district and a private school shall develop a cardiac emergency response plan which includes procedural instructions, a listing of every AED location and information on Hands-only CPR and AED use to teachers, coaches, etc.*

GOOD SAMARITAN LAWS:

Illinois Compiled Statutes -- § 410 ILCS 4/30 Exemption from civil liability

- *Uses key verbiage to describe immunity from civil damages for schools who own, occupy or manage the premises where an AED is located*

Illinois Compiled Statutes -- § 745 ILCS 49/12 Use of an automated external defibrillator: exemption from civil liability for emergency care.
