SCHOOLS:

AED Placement

Kentucky Revised Statutes -- § 158.162. Mandatory adoption of emergency management response plan in each school – Emergency response drills – Consequence of schools failing to comply.

- *Mandates that each local board of education requires a portable automated external defibrillator in a public, readily accessible, well-marked location in every middle and high school building and as funds become available, at school-sanctioned middle and high school athletic practices and competitions*
- *Also outlines policies and procedures for compliance with **KRS 311.665 to KRS 311.669:***
 - *for use, training, maintenance, notification, and communication with local EMS*
- *mandates that by November 1 of each school year, there must be a submission of an annual report to the Kentucky Department of Education and specifies what that report must include*

CPR/AED Training for staff and/or Cardiac Emergency Response Plans (CERP) and/or Emergency Action Plans (EAP)

Kentucky Revised Statutes -- § 158.162. Mandatory adoption of emergency management response plan in each school – Emergency response drills – Consequence of schools failing to comply.

- *Mandates that each local board of education / principal adopt an emergency plan. The plan shall include: procedures to be followed, written CERP, copy of the school mapping data clearly identifying the location of each AED, annual review and discussion with staff.*

- *Mandates that each local board of education require a portable automated external defibrillator in a public, readily accessible, well-marked location in every middle and high school building and as funds become available, at school-sanctioned middle and high school athletic practices and competitions*
- *Also outlines policies and procedures for compliance with **KRS 311.665, KRS 311.669 and KRS 311.667:***
 - *for use, training, maintenance, notification, and communication with local EMS*

CPR/AED Training for coaches and/or Cardiac Emergency Response Plans (CERP) and/or Emergency Action Plans (EAP)

Kentucky Revised Statutes -- § 158.162. Mandatory adoption of emergency management response plan in each school – Emergency response drills – Consequence of schools failing to comply.

- *Mandates the CERP be rehearsed by simulation prior to the beginning of each athletic season by all athletic trainers, school nurses, athletic directors and coaches*

Kentucky Revised Statutes -- § 160.445 – Sports safety course required for high school athletic coaches

- *Outlines requirements for the development of a school campus or athletic event-specific written cardiac emergency response plan, including distribution and annual review with needed revisions, who is required to rehearse the CERP and what must be submitted to the state board or its agency*

GOOD SAMARITAN LAWS:

Kentucky Revised Statutes -- § 311.668. Immunity from civil liability for user of automated external defibrillator.

- *Uses key verbiage to describe liability for any civil damages for persons rendering emergency care, including the use of an AED.*
