SCHOOLS:

AED Placement

New York Education Law - § 917 Educ. On-site cardiac automated external defibrillator

- *School districts, boards of coop educational services and vocational and charter schools shall provide and maintain an on-site AED*

New York Code of Rules and Regulations, 8 NYCRR 136.4. On-site cardiac automated external defibrillators.

- *Mandates that all school districts, boards of cooperative educational services, county vocational education and extension boards and charter schools shall provide and maintain on-site AED equipment*
 - *Also outlines how to determine adequate quantity, which activities require the presence of trained personnel, when to ensure that an AED is provided on-site when off campus, and defines liability for schools because they are a “public access defibrillation provider”*

CPR/AED Training for staff and/or Cardiac Emergency Response Plans (CERP) and/or Emergency Action Plans (EAP)

New York Education Law - § 917 Educ. On-site cardiac automated external defibrillator

- *Whenever public-school facilities are used for school sponsored extracurricular activities or athletic contests, the school officials shall ensure the presence of at least one staff member who is trained in the operation and use of an AED*

YOUTH SPORTS GROUPS:

AED Placement

New York Public Health Law - §3000-f. Automated external defibrillator; camps and youth sports programs.

- *Each camp and youth sports program that either hosts or participates in athletic activities in which at least 5 teams are participating shall establish an AED implementation plan that describes how the camp/program will: make an AED available, provide at least one trained person at each game or practice, and implement an equipment checklist and cardiac emergency protocol*

CPR/AED Training for coaches and/or Cardiac Emergency Response Plans (CERP) and/or Emergency Action Plans (EAP)

New York Code of Rules and Regulations, 8 NYCRR 136.4. On-site cardiac automated external defibrillators.

- *Outlines when an instructional school facility is used for curricular or extracurricular events or an athletic contest, at least one staff person who is trained must be on-site*

N.Y. Comp. Codes R. & Regs. tit. 8§ 135.5. First aid knowledge and skills requirements for coaches

- *Outlines that all coaches must hold valid certification in first aid and adult CPR*

New York Education Law - § 917 Educ. On-site cardiac automated external defibrillator

- *Whenever public-school facilities are used for school sponsored extracurricular activities or athletic contests, the school officials should ensure the presence of at least one staff member who is trained in the operation and use of an AED. It also outlines that public school officials should ensure an AED is on-site even when the athletic activity is off campus.*
