SCHOOLS:

AED Placement

Utah Administrative Code -- §R277-471-4 – School Safety Construction Requirements

- *(5) Upon new construction or major remodeling of a school building, there should be coordination between state, county and school safety and security directors/chiefs to ensure accessible and strategically placed AEDs. One shall be located at or near the main office with additional AEDs within 500 feet of the following areas: gymnasiums, auditoriums, any portable or temporary outbuildings and centralized locations of buildings.*

CPR/AED Training for coaches and/or Cardiac Emergency Response Plans (CERP) and/or Emergency Action Plans (EAP)

GOOD SAMARITAN LAWS:

Utah Code -- §26B-4-302 – Authority to administer CPR or use an AED

- *Authorizes a person to administer CPR and use an AED on another person without a license or certificate if the person reasonably believes that the other person is in sudden cardiac arrest*

Utah Code §26B-4-303 - Immunity

- *Uses key verbiage to describe liability for any civil damages for persons rendering emergency care, including the use of an AED.*
